Yard Waste

The yard waste roll-off dumpster has arrived.

Deposit your grass and branches in the dumpster located on the east side of City Hall. You do not have to bag your grass. No branches larger than the diameter of a pop can.

The yard waste dumpster will not be available the week of clean up. Please save your yard waste until the yard waste dumpster is back at City Hall.

Pet Clinic

May 20th from 5-7pm will be this year's annual Pet Clinic provided by the Enderlin Vet Clinic. Dr. Peterson and his staff set up in the City Hall back garage and provide shots for your pets.

Pet Licenses

All cats and dogs over the age of 6 months are required to be licensed annually at a cost of \$3 per license. Renew your license during regular office hours or during the Pet Clinic.

Spring Clean Up

next to the shed? Can I toss some of these boxes in the basement? **Spring Clean Up will be May 19-21.**

No curbside pickup. All items are to be brought to the east side of City Hall and deposited in the roll-off dumpsters provided.

Items accepted include paint cans with lids off and dry, chairs, couches, mattresses, and misc. furniture. No hazardous waste, oil, paint, liquids in any form, tires or batteries! No large amounts of construction materials.

Please do not put any appliances in these dumpsters. You can place them in the designated area by the dumpsters.

Do not discard your grass clippings, leaves, branches, or tree limbs. Please wait until the yard waste dumpster is back at City Hall after clean up days.

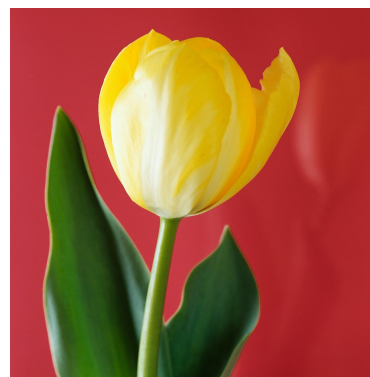

General Permit Information

When do I need a permit?

Permits are required for room additions, decks, porches, finished basements, wood stoves, masonry fireplaces, interior modifications, window replacement of different size, structural renovations or repair, demolition work, accessory structures, swimming pools, new roofs, re-siding, and fences.

A permit is NOT needed

to: Paint a house or erect an accessory building having a floor area of 120 sq ft or less.

Where do I obtain a permit?

You will need to visit Moore Engineering's Building Inspections Department at 925 10th Ave. E., West Fargo for all permits EXCEPT fence permits. **You can obtain a fence permit at City Hall.**

Rummage

Having a rummage sale? Let City Hall know and your sale will be announced on the cable TV community channel and city website "What's Happening" page.

Swimming Pool

Lightowler Johnson Associates has been hired and we are in the design phase. A great deal of research has been done on funding options. The City Council is reviewing all the options and getting advice from our CPA. Our intention is to fund as much of the project ourselves without having to turn to you for help. But, the reality of it is a new pool is a very expensive endeavor.

We want your input. On the June 10th election ballot will be a question asking if you would be willing to financially support building a new pool through an increase in taxes, specials, or a utility surcharge. We are not asking which of these options you would prefer, we are simply finding out if you are willing to help out. Your answer will not commit you to anything, it's simply an Advisory question. But it will give us a better idea of how much support we have in this project.

We will be fundraising and applying for grants where possible. Donations are appreciated.
