the bathhouse.

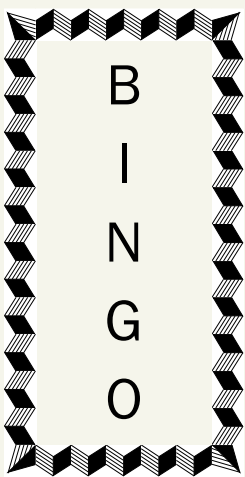
If you have already made a donation, you will be included on the sign or wall. Fill out the form and indicate a donation has already been given

Ordinance Changes

- Any person under 21 years of age may enter and remain in a licensed bar until 9pm to consume a meal if the individual is accompanied by a parent or guardian who is 21 years of age or older.
- The use of tobacco products is prohibited in city-owned or leased parks and recreational facilities, including both outdoor and enclosed areas. This prohibition includes all facilities at which parks and recreation-sponsored activities occur. No person shall use any tobacco products at or on any outdoor or enclosed areas of City-owned or operated recreational facilities, including playgrounds, athletic fields, restrooms, spectator areas, enclosed buildings, concession areas and parking lots. Recreational facilities include, but are not limited to, the Memorial Building, Kindred Pool and park shelters.
- Any person who is at least 12 years of age may use, explode or possess any fireworks within the city limits during the period between July 3 through July 5 until 11pm. Use, explosion, or possession of fireworks at any other time during the year is prohibited.
- Habitual barking, crying or howling for repeated intervals of at least 3 minutes with less than one minute of interruption is considered a public nuisance. Any person who would like to file a complaint may do so through City Hall or contact Cass County Sheriff dispatch at 451-7660.
