Pool

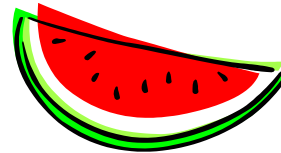
The pool has been our headline for many newsletters. We are so happy to see so many kids and families enjoying themselves!
