Changes - They are a comin'

The **Yard Waste Dumpster** is going to be moved to the city shop at 951 Elm St. which is located at the west end of town. This new location may be a temporary move - it depends on how it is goes. Just a reminder that only yard waste is to be deposited into this dumpster (grass & leaves in bags are fine). Trees need to be cut up. No dumping on the ground. There is a platform there to assist in getting the material into the dumpster. This service is for city residents only. If we find material other than yard waste in the dumpster, it will be moved back to City Hall where it is monitored by cameras.

Effective October 1, 2016 **garbage rates** will be going up 1% to match an increase from Waste Management due to a disposal rate increase by the City of Fargo.

Effective January 1, 2017 **water rates** will be increasing. The rate charged to you for a minimum of 2000 gallons is currently \$27.98 and will increase to \$28.53.
