Permits

When do I need a permit? Permits are required for any structural changes, repairs, or additions, decks, porches, finished basements, wood stoves, masonry fireplaces, window replacement of different size, demolition work, accessory structures, new roofs, re-siding, and fences.

A permit is NOT needed to: Paint a house, shingle, or erect a shed having a floor area of 120 sq. ft. or less.

Where do I obtain a permit? You will need to visit Moore Engineering's Building Inspections Department at 800 4th Ave. E., West Fargo for all permits EXCEPT fence permits.

You can obtain a fence permit at City Hall.

Spring Clean Up

Clean out the garage. What's next to the shed? Can I toss some of these boxes in the basement? Get rid of it **May 1-3**.

No curbside pickup. All items are to be brought to the east side of City Hall and deposited in the roll-off dumpsters provided.

Items accepted include paint cans with lids off and dry, chairs, couches, mattresses, TV's, and misc. furniture. No hazardous waste, oil, paint, liquids in any form, tires or batteries! No large amounts of construction materials.

Please do not put any appliances in these dumpsters.

Do not discard your grass clippings, leaves, branches, or tree limbs. The yard waste dumpster will return to its location at the west end of Elm St. after clean up days.



Yard Waste

The yard waste roll-off dumpster has arrived. Deposit your grass and branches in the dumpster located on the west side of town across the RR tracks. You do not have to bag your grass. No branches larger than the diameter of a pop can. **DO NOT deposit clippings on the ground if the dumpster is full. Please wait for an empty dumpster to arrive.**

The yard waste dumpster will not be available the week of clean up. Please save your yard waste until the yard waste dumpster has returned.

Recycling

Effective the week of May 8, 2017, recycling collection will be done **every other GOLD week** on Tuesday. Your first recycling will be Tuesday May 9, 2017.

Due to this new collection schedule, there will be **NO** collection on May 2, 2017.

The city council approved this change on April 5, 2017. This every-other-week recycling adds \$1.75 to your water bill to be reflected on the bill you receive in June.

Water Wonders

Ever wonder how much water is wasted by a leak? The graph below shows the number of gallons wasted. A dripping faucet can waste 3 gallons of water a day.

Ever wonder how to check to see if you have a leak? First, locate your water meter inside your house. Next, the last thing you do before going to bed is to write down the meter reading. Finally, the first thing (before going to the bathroom) is write down the meter reading again. If the numbers aren't the same - you have a leak.

Ever wonder how to check to see if your toilet is leaking? Add a couple drops of food coloring in the *TANK*. If the water in the *BOWL* turns color, it is leaking.
